Planning - Plans were passed for a new house in School Lane opposite the Village Hall and construction is already underway. Permission has been refused for a single dwelling between Leycroft and the new tennis court in Holcot Lane.

An application has been received for outline permission for residential development for a site in Old Road. The sketch scheme proposed has been opposed by the Parish Council. No decision has yet been received.

Annual Parish Meeting - At this meeting the Parish Council presented its report and accounts for the past year. There was some discussion of the problems of the maintenance of the recreation field and it was agreed that the Parish Council would look into the matter further. The Charities and other village societies also presented their reports.

We are all very grateful to Mrs. Alcock for her years of work at the Post Office.
