Following the DFE review of play funding, which almost certainly mean we will lose our 49k playbuilder funding, the SPFCG have submitted a second stage application to Biffaward for 50k. The Biffaward board will be reviewing this in

January 2011, so more news after this, fingers crossed!

We are also embarking on an application for a lottery grant 'Community Spaces', and have details of several more funding sources which we will be applying to over the next couple of months.
