The Parish Council have requested a precept of £10750 for 2008/09. This is an increase of 7.5% from 2007/08 to allow for the costs of purchasing the playing field from Daventry District Council and the costs of the potential election in May'08. For a Band 'D' property approximately £76 of your annual Council Tax will go to the Parish Council in 2008/09, an increase of about £5 over the year from 2007/08.
