Joseph Smart left of age and attendance.

(NB To leave school a child was required to be over a certain age and have the required attendance marks on the register. He or she would have to stay at school until the number of attendances needed was reached, regardless of age.

Jan 31st

The two Buswells absent with badly chilled feet.

Feb 28th

Attendance fell off because of heavy snow

Mar 20th

Sir Vere Isham and Captain Soames visited and looked at the drawing and drill. Attendance 58
