Crime in Scaldwell

In recent weeks there have been 4 illegal entries into 3 outbuildings in Scaldwell. In one at the Brixworth end of the High Street a considerable amount of meat was taken from the freezer. On the second occasion, a garage of a house in the centre of the High Street was broken into twice, but fortunately, little was taken due to the foresight of the owner securely chaining up his motorcycle.

It seems that Scaldwell is plagued on a yearly basis with shed and garage robberies, so please secure these buildings and the more valuable objects in them.

The third incident was very different. On the night 22/23 August a car believed to have been concerned in a mini crime wave between Denton and Scaldwell was seen by police. The police finally cornered 3 men in Scaldwell Churchyard and sent in the dogs. They captured 2 of the men, but the 3rd escaped through the allotments and into the garden of a house where he got into the garage and made his escape. The police believe they may know his identity.
