Scaldwell E-group

An e-group works like this. Anyone with an email address (home or work) who wishes to join sends their email details to a moderator (possibly a small committee) who vets the application. The vetting procedure is to ensure that only people with legitimate interest can join.

If you are accepted your e-mail address is added to a special mailing list of members held by a service provider (probably Yahoo).

The service provider gives a single e-mail address to this mailing list – it would probably be scaldwell@yahoogroups.com. Any e-mail sent to this address will automatically be sent to all group members – simple as that.

Thus if you want to send any information or requests for information to all members of the group you simply send a single e-mail to scaldwell@yahoogroups.com and as a result your single e-mail is sent to everyone.
