The Parish Council met on Wednesday 20th September when council appointed Matthew Wharton as the Police Liaison Representative. He will act as the point of contact between the council and the police. The role is to co-ordinate with the Council across a number of Police related activities. e.g. Liaise with Neighbourhood Policing team, Report on Crime Stats/ Neighbourhood watch, PCSO contact, etc.

Those villagers who use the Playing Field will have noticed some changes have occurred since council approved the release of funds for safety work to be carried out. We have had to remove the sand pit and various pieces of wooden equipment.

Council gave approval for the removal of 'the Suspended walkway', again due to health and safety reasons, and this will occur shortly.

However, it is hoped that later this year or early next, we will be in a position to add new equipment to the playing Field.

Council would like to thank all those involved in the very successful 'Party in the Park' event in August.

The council now own the telephone kiosk and we are in the process of obtaining quotes for tidy up work to be carried out before a defibrillator is installed. We will continue to keep the village informed of progress. Please note that the phone has now been fully de-commissioned.

As you will have noticed, The Green is in need of repair, as are other green areas around the village. Council has decided to hold off repairing the Green till early next spring when it will be part of a wider exercise to tidy up/repair the various green spaces in the village.

Thank you to all who put forward suggestions regarding a plaque on the bench outside Stabilised Pavements Ltd (SPL). We hope to be able to inform you of the outcome, via the website, once we have spoken to Gerry Howe.

The next Parish Council meeting will be held at 7.30pm in the Village Hall on the second Wednesday in October - the 11th - and not the third, which is our usual custom. All parishioners are most welcome to attend.

Scaldwell Parish Trust and Relief in Need Charity

There will be a meeting of the Trustees on 8th November to consider grant applications.

Neighbourhood Watch

- ❖ Northants residents are receiving scam BT calls. NEVER allow an unsolicited caller to take control of your computer
- ❖ We have been asked to circulate the following message.

Northamptonshire has in the past five years experienced an increase in theft offences across the county at this time of year, with last year being particularly high.

To this end, Northamptonshire Police will be running a force-wide operation between 25 September to the 30 November focussing on theft offences that cause the most harm to victims such as dwelling burglary, non-dwelling and theft from motor vehicle.

There will be dedicated patrols in place over this period. We will be looking at engaging with communities around crime prevention advice and intelligence gathering. There will be media coverage around this campaign during this period.

If you have anything to report around suspicious activity or something you have witnessed please call 101 or in an emergency call 999.

- ❖ Nottingham Knockers. These door-do-door salesmen may say that they are on a rehabilitation course arranged by probations services or other organisations trying to find people work. This is not the case and often they are known criminals. Probation services do not run such schemes.

They may show a card that claims to be a licence or work permit. This is not valid and they are breaking the law if they show one. They have been in the village over the past few weeks so if you are concerned ring the police on 101.
