We are aware that the newly laid surface to the side roads is causing many problems and have repeatedly reported it to the Highways department. Although they are suggesting that the surface will improve with wear, we consider this unsatisfactory and are still requesting some remedial action. However, in the mean time, we would urge you to take extra care in icy or wet conditions.

The village greens are constantly damaged by vehicles, and our intention is to place posts strategically on the corners which seem to suffer most. It is felt that we should wait until all the road re-surfacing has been completed, but we shall be re-seeding the damaged areas in order to improve their appearance.

Could we please request that vehicles parking around the Greens should keep off of the grass, as we have noticed that this is eroding the Green and is a particular problem when functions are being held in the Church or the Village Hall. We appreciate that is mainly caused by visitors to the Village but if friends or relatives are made aware it might prevent further damage.

We are told that the pavements in the High Street are due to be re-surfaced shortly. This is likely to cause some disruption, and may take several weeks.

We understand that there has been a problem with rats throughout the county, and although they may not be visible, they may be around bins looking for food. They are a very serious health hazard and, as they carry several diseases, we

are reminded to always wash hands thoroughly after touching the bins. If you do see any signs of rats in the Village please report it to the Environmental Health Department at DDC (01327-871100 or 01327-302277 out of hours).

Parish council elections will be held on **May 1st**, and anyone who would like to stand should obtain nomination papers from the Clerk. These must be returned to DDC by noon on **April 4th**. The elected Council will serve for a term of four years, and we would encourage everyone to vote, as the Council should represent the views of the whole village. The first meeting of the newly elected Council will take place on **May 7th at 7.30pm**.

The Annual Parish Meeting will take place on **Wednesday April 23rd at 7.30pm**. This is an opportunity for all the organisations within the village to report on their activities during the past year. Everyone is welcome.

Excerpts from the Scaldwell School Log Book

1909

April 2nd

Edith Middleton withdrawn as her mother having been obliged to go into the workhouse

June 25th

Heavy rains. Children at a distance could not attend

July 2nd

Albert Sharp withdrawn. Grandfather with whom he lived has left the village

July 9th

Holiday given Monday for the Feast.

NB Scaldwell Feast carried on until WW2. Originally to commemorate the Saints to whom the Church is dedicated. Local traders, pedlars and small time showmen would set up stalls on the green.
